

Information concerning our second exam

Our second exam will be a take home exam, distributed on Wednesday April 15 and due on Monday April 20. This does not mean that it is expected to take you five days! My goal will be to design a 2-3 hour exam. The exam will focus on understanding the major arguments from our worksheets and tying them together. When doing the exam, you may consult your own notes and the worksheets/problem sets on the course website, but no other sources; I therefore encourage you to prepare notes for the exam in advance. I recommend considering the following problems to prepare:
